IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

IMPORTANT DATES:

May 4: Voter registration deadline

May 12: Last day to apply for an absentee ballot to mail

May 14: Last day to apply for an absentee ballot in person

May 18: Last day to hand-deliver absentee ballot

May 19: Absentee ballots returned by mail must be received by noon

VOTER REGISTRATION FORM:



Note that the voter registration application may be used to register to vote OR update your voter registration information. Be advised that any voter registration information provided by an applicant may be verified against federal immigration records to determine citizenship or immigration status. Voter registration is open all year, **except during the 14 days prior to an election and on Election Day**. If registering to vote using a mail-in form, the registration form must be postmarked no later than the registration deadline for an election. (in this case, postmarked no later than May 4th). TO UPDATE VOTER REGISTRATION DUE TO A CHANGE IN NAME OR ADDRESS:

TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT:



- Voters may cast an absentee ballot if they:
 - Expect to be absent from the county on election day
 - Are ill or have a physical infirmity that prevents the voter from being able to access their assigned polling place
 - Are a registered Alabama voter living outside the county including but not limited to: members of the armed forces or a spouse or dependent of such a person, or a U.S. citizen residing overseas or students at an educational institution located outside their county of residence
 - Are an appointed election official or poll watcher at a polling place other than their regular polling place
 - Expect to work a required workplace shift which has at least 10 hours which coincide with regular polling hours
 - Are a caregiver for a family member to the second degree of kinship by affinity or consanguinity and the family member is confined to their own home
 - Are incarcerated in prison / jail and have not been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude

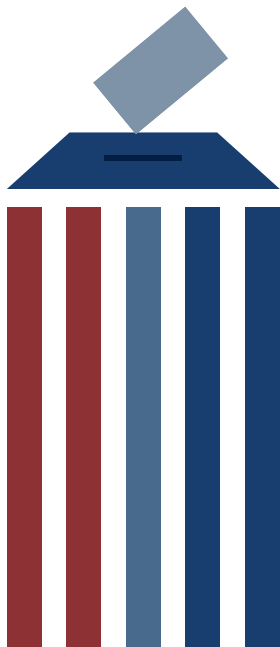
