
2021 Bright Ideas Grant Program Application

- 1. Individual teachers may apply for funds up to \$750. Teams of teachers may apply for up to \$1,500 (maximum amount).
- 2. Principal's signature is required on hard copy that is sent to cooperative. Please keep a copy for your records.
- 3. Only one application per project per school will be accepted.
- 4. Proof of project/program completion is required by the end of the school year for which the grant is requested for. The teacher(s) should also make arrangement with CAEC for a documentation opportunity. Proof of completion can be through photographs or visits by CAEC employees and trustees.
- 5. **Grants are not intended for equipment or capital investments** (ex: IPads, tablets, computers, printers, projectors, playgrounds) unless the equipment is used in conjunction with a creative initiative.
